A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, COLORADO EXTENDING THE DATE FOR FILING OF BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown is a Colorado municipal corporation operating under a Territorial Charter and governed by its Board of Selectmen; and

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized to adopt such rules, regulations and restrictions for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges the hardship imposed on retail businesses within the Town by the COVID-19 emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the importance and significance of retail businesses to the health and vitality of the Town generally, and to the Town government itself, in that the Town is funded in major part with sales tax revenues; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that assistance from the Town is necessary to support retail businesses during this time in order to avert significant economic loss to the Town generally, and the Town budget in particular; and

WHEREAS, in order to assist local businesses within the Town, the Board of Selectmen has determined it is necessary to delay the renewal deadline for business licenses until the end of the first quarter of the year 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Georgetown, Colorado:

Section 1. Local retail business license renewal deadline extended. The Board of Selectmen hereby extends the renewal deadline for all business licenses until March 31, 2021.

Section 2. Effective date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
