A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, COLORADO WAIVING ONE MONTH OF WATER AND SEWER UTILITIES CHARGES FOR CERTAIN BUSINESSES WITHIN THE TOWN

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown is a Colorado municipal corporation operating under a Territorial Charter and governed by its Board of Selectmen; and

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized to adopt such rules, regulations and restrictions for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges the hardship imposed on retail businesses within the Town by the COVID-19 emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the importance and significance of retail businesses to the health and vitality of the Town generally, and to the Town government itself, in that the Town is funded in major part with sales tax revenues; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that assistance from the Town is necessary to support retail businesses during this time in order to avert significant economic loss to the Town generally, and the Town budget in particular; and

WHEREAS, due to state and county-imposed occupancy restrictions, restaurants and bars within the Town have experienced severely reduced business; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to assist such businesses by waiving one month of utility charges.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Georgetown, Colorado:

Section 1. Water and sewer charges waived. The Board of Selectmen hereby waives the base EQR water and sewer utility charges for all bars and restaurants open to the public at retail within the Town for the month of December 2020.

Section 2. Effective date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
