

Georgetown Road and Bridge Upcoming Work - 2019

R & B is planning on working through our gravel streets this summer to correct as many drainage issues as possible. We will do our best on each street to get streets crowned and water moving off the streets and low spots downhill toward paved street drainage, culverts, and ultimately the creek.

We are getting quotes on some drain pans in a few locations. You might see us shooting grades to determine best method to keep water moving toward outlet areas.

We will put out notices several days in advance of working on your street. Please help us in this work by moving all cars from the street, on the days listed in notices, by 7 a.m. We will do our best to get the work done on the days listed, weather or more pressing matters excepted. Some streets may only take a day; others may take 2-3 days. We are planning on jackhammering out rocks in the subgrade which stick up into the road base interfering with proper grading and causing chuckholes.

Other maintenance items 2019; Maintenance grading/compacting as soon as frost is completely gone beneath roads, potholes, crack sealing, widening where feasible, sidewalk assessments, new striping on Loop Dr. and Argentine, from 11th St. to the town limits past north end of the lake.

Please help our gravel streets last longer by driving at slower speeds on gravel streets. Faster speeds cause washboard which then catch water and turn into chuckholes.
