**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR THE TOWN OF
GEORGETOWN, COLORADO DESIGNATING PUBLIC PLACES FOR THE POSTING
OF NOTICES CONCERNING TOWN OF GEORGETOWN PUBLIC MEETINGS**

WHEREAS, in compliance with the Colorado Sunshine Act of 1972 and amendments thereto, the Georgetown Board of Selectmen desires to designate public places for the posting of notices concerning Town public meetings;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR
GEORGETOWN, COLORADO:**

Section 1. That the bulletin board in the entrance hallway to the Town Hall at 404 6th Street, is designated for Town postings and the bulletin board at the Post Office at 700 6th Street, and at the Town's website: www.townofgeorgetown.us are hereby designated as public posting places for the purpose of giving full and timely notice of Town of Georgetown public meetings.

Section 2. That the designation of a public place by this Resolution shall not be deemed to preclude the Town from providing other or different notice of public meetings, so long as such notice is full and timely and otherwise in compliance with the Colorado Sunshine Act of 1972 and subsequent amendments thereto.
