

**RESOLUTION NO. 7**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, COLORADO REINSTATING SHUTOFFS FOR NON-PAYMENT FOR WATER AND SEWER UTILITIES**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Georgetown is a Colorado municipal corporation operating under a Territorial Charter and governed by its Board of Selectmen; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Selectmen (the "Board") is authorized to adopt such rules, regulations and restrictions for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board acknowledges the hardship imposed on all persons within the Town by the COVID-19 emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board supported local businesses and residents by waiving shutoffs for non payment of utility fees as a temporary measure; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 13.16.090 of the Georgetown Municipal Code states that water or sewer to be shut off for failure to pay and provides for an appeal process; and


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Town of Georgetown, Colorado:

**Section 1. Shutoff of water and sewer utility services for failure to pay be reinstated.** The Board of Selectmen hereby directs Town staff to resume implementing Section 13.16.090 of the Georgetown Municipal Code that water and sewer utility services be shutoff for failure to pay utility fees.

**Section 2. Effective date.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
