

**RESOLUTION NO. 3
(Series of 2019)**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN PROVIDING FOR CONDUCT OF THE APRIL 1, 2019 REGULAR TOWN ELECTION PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES OF THE UNIFORM ELECTION CODE OF 1992, AND IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING FINDINGS AND DIRECTING THAT SAID ELECTION BE CANCELED

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown is a Colorado municipal corporation operating under a Territorial Charter and governed by its Board of Selectmen; and

WHEREAS, the Territorial Charter vests authority in the Board of Selectmen to provide for the conduct of Town elections; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to this authority the Board of Selectmen has previously adopted Chapter 2.56 of the Georgetown Municipal Code, concerning elections; and

WHEREAS, Code Section 2.56.030 provides that all Town elections shall be held in accordance with Colorado Municipal Election Code of 1965, "except that the Board of Selectmen may provide by ordinance or resolution that an election will be conducted under the requirements and procedures of the Uniform Election Code of 1992 with respect to any particular election;" and

WHEREAS, the Board of Selectmen wishes to provide for conduct of the April 1, 2019 regular Town election pursuant to the Uniform Election Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1-5-208 of the Uniform Election Code and Section 2.56.050 of the Georgetown Municipal Code, the Board may cancel the April 1, 2019 election, finding that as of the 63rd day before the election pursuant to CRS § 1-5-208, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR GEORGETOWN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Uniform Election Code adopted for April 1, 2019 election. Pursuant to Section 2.56.030 of the Georgetown Municipal Code, the Board of Selectmen hereby provides that the April 1, 2019 regular election will be conducted under the requirements and procedures of the Uniform Election Code of 1992.

Section 2. Election canceled. Pursuant to § 1-5-208, CRS and Section 2.56.050 of the Georgetown Municipal Code, the Board of Selectmen finds that the only matter before the voters at the April 1, 2019 regular Town election in the election of persons to office, and at the close of business on the 63rd day before the election there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent. Accordingly, the Town Clerk

is hereby instructed to cancel the April 1, 2019 election and to provide notification of such cancellation as required by statute and the Code.

Section 3. Candidates declared elected. Pursuant to CRS § 1-5-208 and Georgetown Municipal Code Section 2.56.050(a) the following nominated candidates are hereby declared elected effective as of the date of the canceled election: April 1, 2019:

- Police Judge: Lynette Kelsey, term to expire April 5, 2021
- Selectman, Ward 1: Rob Connell, term to expire April 3, 2023
- Selectman, Ward 2: Paul Hintgen, term to expire April 3, 2023
- Selectman, Ward 3: Mary Smith, term to expire April 3, 2023

Section 4. Notice of cancellation to be published and posted. Pursuant to Municipal Code Section 2.56.050(b) and CRS § 1-5-208(6), notice of the cancellation of the April 1, 2019 election shall be timely published in a newspaper of general circulation within the Town and said notice shall also be posted at Town Hall, the office of the Clear Creek County Clerk & Recorder, each polling place and all duly designated Town posting locations.

Section 5. Effective date. This resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
