A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, COLORADO APPROVING A LETTER SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION OF THE GEORGETOWN TRUST FOR CONSERVATION AND PRESERVATION, INC. FOR THE RESTORATION AND REHABILITATION OF THE KNEISEL AND SPRUANCE BUILDINGS ON 6TH STREET IN GEORGETOWN.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR GEORGETOWN, COLORADO:

Whereas, the Georgetown Trust for Conservation and Preservation, Inc. has requested a letter of support directed to the Director of the State Historical fund to support the application of the Georgetown Trust for the restoration and rehabilitation of the Kneisel and Spruance buildings on 6th Street in Georgetown; and

Whereas, the application is for the first historic façade restoration in the Georgetown Historic Commercial District, that is located on a structure, that is identified as a Contributing Structure in the National Historic Landmark District, and is in partnership with the ownership of the properties; and

Whereas, the Board of Selectmen finds that it is in the Town's interest to support the application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR GEORGETOWN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The request of the Georgetown Trust for Conservation and Preservation, Inc. for a letter of support as described is hereby approved and the Police Judge is hereby authorized to sign the letter of support as presented to the Board of Selectmen.

Section 2. The Police Judge and Town Staff are further authorized to do all things necessary on behalf of the Town to perform the obligations of the Town under the letter of support and to execute and deliver any and all documents necessary to affect the terms and conditions of such letter of support.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
