**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN,
COLORADO HONORING ALISHA REIS, INTERIM TOWN ADMINISTRATOR, FOR HER ABLE
ASSISTANCE**

Whereas, the Town of Georgetown was faced with the unexpected need for Interim Town Administrator services in July of 2017; and

Whereas, the Board of Selectmen reached out to the professional local government management community for interested persons able to serve as Interim Town Administrator; and

Whereas, the Board of Selectmen was extremely fortunate to have Alisha Reis express an interest in the position; and

Whereas, Alisha Reis was appointed Interim Town Administrator for the Town of Georgetown on July 25, 2017 and has served in that position through January, 2018 as promised; and

Whereas, during her term as Interim Town Administrator, Alisha Reis provided an invaluable, professional, informed and steady hand at the helm of administration for the Town, bringing stability to a situation which desperately required it, and inspiring loyalty and professionalism in all Town employees by demonstrating those qualities herself; and

Whereas, in addition to the challenging task of familiarizing herself with ongoing Town projects, in this very short time Alisha Reis also accomplished, or helped the Board of Selectmen to accomplish, the following significant Town goals:

- Initiation of the Gateway Project
- Assisted the Business Promotions Commission in developing strategies for marketing and advertising
- Completed the 15th Street Bridge project
- Successful approval of the Bighorn Crossing (formerly Rose Mill) development project
- Completion of bidding and positioning for contracting for the Georgetown Lagoon dredging project
- Complete organization of Town Administrator files, projects and protocols
- Superior motivation and a morale boost to all Town Staff
- Competent financial administration
- Thoughtful and timely advice to the Board of Selectmen
- Creation and administration of an informed and productive recruitment process for a permanent Town Administrator; and

Whereas, the Board of Selectmen finds and declares that without Alisha Reis' professional, effective, and personable execution of the duties of Interim Town Administrator, above and beyond all reasonable expectations for such a challenging task, the Town would indeed have suffered greatly; and

Whereas, the Board of Selectmen wishes to memorialize in this Resolution Alisha Reis' accomplishments for and contributions to the Town, all of which are so very much appreciated and which will be gratefully remembered.
